BET / VET

Bet has the sound of "b" as in "boy" (dot) or "v" as in "vine" (no dot)

1

ALEPH

Aleph has no sound of its own, but usually has a vowel associated with it

4

DALET

has the sound of "d" as in "door"
Sounds the same with(out) dot

3

GIMMEL

has the sound of "g" as in "girl"
Sounds the same with(out) dot

6

VAV

has the sound of "v" as in "vine."
Can be used as a vowel

5

HEY

has the sound of "h" as in "hay."

8

CHET

has the (light scraping) sound of "ch" as in "Bach."

7

ZAYIN

has the sound of "z" as in "zebra."

10

YOD

has the sound of "y" as in "yes."
Can be used as a vowel

9

TET

has the sound of "t" as in "tall."

12

LAMED

has the sound of "l" as in "look."

11

KAF / KHAF

has the sound of "k" as in "kite" (dot)
or "ch" as in Bach (no dot)
Note Sofit (ending) form

14

NUN

has the sound of "n" as in "now."
Note Sofit (ending) form

13

MEM

has the sound of "m" as in "mom."
Note Sofit (ending) form

16

AYIN

Like Aleph, Ayin has no sound of its own, but usually has a vowel associated with it.

15

SAMEKH

has the sound of "s" as in "son."

18

TZADE

has the sound of “ts” as in “*nuts*.”

Note Sofit (ending) form

17

PEY / FEY

has the sound of “p” as in “*park*” (dot) or

“f” as in “*fun*”(no dot).

Note Sofit (ending) form

20

RESH

has the sound of “r” as in “*rain*.”

19

QOF

has the sound of “q” as in “*queen*.”

22

TAV

has the sound of “t” as in “*tall*.”

Sounds the same with(out) dot

21

SHIN / SIN

has the sound of “sh” as in “*shy*” (right dot)

or “s” as in sun (left dot)
