Recite John 8:12

"I am the light of the world. "Blessed are You, LORD our God, King of the universe, Who sanctifies us with his commandments and commanded us to kindle the light of Chanukah."

"And all throughout the eight days of Chanukah, these lights are holy, and we are not permitted to make use of them, but only to behold them, in order to offer thanks and praise to your great Name for Your miracles, for your wonders and for your salvation."
